ACCESS and Alt. ACCESS	K-12	January 25 - Feb 25	Assessment Language and Culture Required	Measures student's English language proficiency. All students identified as English Learners are required to take this assessment until they reach proficiency. There is also an Alternate ACCESS for student who have an Alternate Assessment Addendum in their IEP. When a student enrolls in a NM school, they are required to complete a LUS, Language Usage Survey. If they indicate on the LUS that a language other than English is used, then they must be given the WIDA Screener. If the student cannot score proficient on the screener they are identified as an EL.
