NMSU's THRIVE Program follows a mini-semester, hybrid model where candidates will complete an Alternative Licensure Program for Special Education in two semesters while obtaining classroom experience by being paired with a cooperating mentor teacher.

Benefits:

- Full Scholarship for program at NMSU
- \$20,000 stipend while you're completing the program
- Courses can be rolled over towards a master's degree
- Guaranteed employment with cooperating district upon successful completion of program
- Participants commit 3-years of employment with cooperating district (contingent on meeting teacher evaluation criteria)
- Receive second year of mentorship from cooperating mentor teacher
